PKSC Grants Chairman Report 2022/23

The last year has, again, been a year where Perth and Kinross Sports Council have worked to aid local clubs and individuals through the post covid period.

In the period we awarded £10,000 of grants, not including the George Mortimer bursary, and the awards made throughout 2022 showed, yet again, the broad and diverse talent that our local area has in both team sports and individual athletes.

To clubs, we awarded 18 Grants. 71% of the total grants (£7,050) with equipment grants making up the majority of the requests.

For individuals, we awarded 29% of the total grants (£2,950) across 8 sports, with Hockey players making up a third of those awarded (5 of 15 Individual grants).

We also funded the George Mortimer Bursary this year, supporting a school leaver to continue their sporting achievements in further education.

With Event grants making up fewer of the club's awards, it is important that the Sports Council should use the 2023/24 period to understand what part it can play to help assist clubs put on more competitions and events in the local area.

To Perth and Kinross Council, I would like to thank them for their continued financial support which allows us to support Sport in our local community. Also, to Live Active Leisure for their continued administrative support.
